The Public Safety Emergency Vehicle Operator Course is a specialized training program designed to equip first responders with the skills and mindset necessary to operate emergency vehicles safely under high-stress conditions. The curriculum covers defensive driving techniques, vehicle dynamics, legal responsibilities, skid control and recovery, and collision avoidance. Participants practice and develop hands-on skills in precision maneuvering, advanced braking, evasive maneuvering, and backing on a closed course. Law Enforcement, Fire, and EMS personnel are welcome to attend this 16-hour TCOLE credit course.
